

## Art Scholarship Guidelines

The assessment for the Art Scholarship is intended to discover artistic ability and potential. Candidates need to show creative promise and enthusiasm when making or discussing art. Accordingly, candidates are required to submit a portfolio\* which can include a range of drawings, paintings and photographs of large pieces (bigger than A3) or three-dimensional works. These should be clearly divided into two categories:

- work carried out under supervision at school
- work carried out in the candidate's own time

The portfolio should be brought to The Cedars on assessment day. No framed works should be included. We are looking for evidence of the creative process (in sketchbooks or on paper) as well as finished works.

Potential candidates for art scholarships need to pass the school's entrance assessment.

## **ASSESSMENT PROCESS**

- Candidates for Art Scholarships at The Cedars School will be given an art activity to complete in workshop setting lasting 90 mins.
- Candidates will also need to provide a portfolio that contains no more than 10 pieces of interesting work, this can include sketch books and work in progress.
- Candidates are required to discuss their work and art exhibitions that have enjoyed, in a short interview with the Head of Art.

## **CONDITIONS**

As a condition of their award, Art Scholars are required:

- to participate fully in school's art activities appropriate to their talents and to meet the high standards expected by The Cedars School;
- to produce work for exhibitions and attend school gallery events
- Study Art as an exam subject

The acceptance by parents or guardians of any award offered after the assessment constitutes their agreement to these conditions. Failure to meet these conditions could lead to an award being withdrawn.

\*Portfolio – a simple folder containing a collection of art works. You are not required to buy a portfolio for this application, home-made or 'well-loved' portfolios often hold the most interesting
