QUESTIONS ANSWERED

What happens when a death occurs?

The sooner you contact the funeral home, the sooner we can begin helping you. Even if you are not ready for the funeral home to come to the place of death to transport the deceased, it is helpful to notify us so that we may be able to guide you through the next steps.

How long can a family delay services before the deceased can't have an open casket?

Every situation is unique, and the circumstances surrounding the death play an important role in determining the length of time a body can be held. However, as a general rule, a deceased body can be shown after several days have passed since the time of death, perhaps longer.

What happens when my loved one passes away while out of state?

Contact the funeral home that you ultimately will be using for services. We will arrange for a funeral home in that area to assist us with necessary arrangements.

Who contacts the newspaper about obituary notices?

Although a family can choose to take care of the obituary on their own, it is part of our service to assist in the writing and submitting of the obituary to the newspapers.

Has anyone ever had a funeral with viewing and then later cremated for final resting?

This is a common service in our area. We offer caskets that can be used for viewing and later cremated, or a rental casket that can be used for this type of service. We feel that viewing the deceased is a very important part of a service even if the ultimate disposition is cremation. The funeral for this type of service is very similar to that of someone who chose to be buried. At the end of the service, instead of going to the cemetery, the deceased is brought back to the funeral home for cremation.

How does the cremation process work?

For cremation to take place, the family must sign an authorization form provided by the funeral home and the coroner or medical examiner from the county of death must sign a cremation permit. Once these documents are obtained, the body is placed in a rigid container for the cremation process. Unless a body has been embalmed, Iowa law states that cremation must take place within 72 hours.

How much can I personalize my Celebration of Life at the Brosh Chapel & The Avacentre?

We encourage families to make the service as personal as possible. We accommodate families in making their service special in any way that we can within legal and ethical standards. By bringing in meaningful items and creating ways to display the different aspects of a person's life, the funeral home can be transformed to suit each service uniquely. Our printed materials including the register book, memorial folders, and thank you cards are no longer the "cookie cutter" stock. We are able to reflect the individual personality of the life being celebrated.

Is Brosh Chapel able to help with military burial benefits and a military service?

We will help your family determine which benefits the veteran may be eligible for - then we will fill out any and all veteran's application forms and submit to the Government on your behalf. We handle all of the arrangements and details surrounding military honors, and supply each veteran's family with a flag. We also communicate with the Veterans Administration regarding every veteran that we serve. They contact each family regarding benefits that they may be eligible for.

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provided describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF..... **\$3150**

Our charge for basic services includes, but is not limited to:

- The services of our funeral directors and staff to respond to initial request for service
- Arrangement conference
- Arrangement of the Celebration of Life
- Filing of necessary authorizations and permits
- Recording vital statistics
- Preparation and placement of obituary notices
- Staff assistance prior to and following the Celebration of Life, including coordination of service plans with cemetery, crematory and any other parties involved. Also included in this charge are operation costs relative to our facilities, professional licensing, legal and accounting, insurance, utilities, maintenance, taxes, furnishings, inventory cost and administrative expense. **This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial and forwarding or receiving of remains.**

PREPARATION OF THE DECEASED: Embalming & Restorative Arts.....

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that doesn't require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, or when refrigeration or dry ice is available.

Our services will include set-up and use of visitation/gathering area, placement of casket, urn or memorabilia. Use of equipment, display of floral arrangements, direction of visitors, and general supervision. Up to 4 hours the day before and 1 hour the day of the Celebration of Life, within our chapel, *The Avacentre*, or at another location.

Same Day Viewing/Visitation or Gathering

Immediately prior to and same day as the Celebration of Life. Up to 3 hours or less - within our facilities or at another local venue.....**\$400**

Same Day Basic Viewing/Visitation or Gathering

Immediately prior to and the same day as the Celebration of Life. Up to 1 hour within our facilities or another local venue.....**\$300**

Private Family Identification

Up to 1/2 hour with immediate family only..**\$100**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, other preparation of the deceased, local transfer of deceased to Brosh Chapel, use of facilities, equipment and staff for visitation/gathering and Celebration of Life in our chapel, *The Avacentre*, or other local venue, local use of automotive equipment, which includes use of funeral coach (hearse) & the utility/service vehicle.

ADDITIONAL CREMATION SERVICES

DIRECT CREMATION.....\$3250 to \$18,750

Direct cremation includes a proportionate share of the basic services of the funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to our funeral chapel, alternative sanitary care of the deceased, assistance with necessary paperwork and placement of obituaries. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you may use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The alternative containers we provide are constructed of cardboard.

OUR PAYMENT POLICY

We are a family oriented business and we treat every family we serve as fairly and equally as we can. In an effort to provide the finest services possible, we request that the total of all cash advance items be paid either at the time of the arrangement conference or prior to the funeral services or the final disposition of the deceased. The balance of the goods and services selected is due within 30 days of the arrangement conference. Any unpaid balances will be subject to 18% per annum interest charges - assessed monthly until balance is paid in full.

We offer a variety of payment options which include:

- Payment by a pre-paid funeral contract with our funeral chapel or transferred from another funeral home.
- Payment in cash, personal check or MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express. We offer a 2% discount on the funeral home's charges, excluding cash advance items, when paid by cash or check within 10 days from the date the purchase agreement is signed.
- As a convenience to the families that we serve, we will accept credit cards, or an assignment from the proceeds of a valid life insurance policy. 3.5% Fees may be applied for this convenience service.
