WELCOME TO OUR PARISH

"The souls of the righteous are in the hand of God,"

Just two weeks ago, religious intolerance in England reared its ugly head with the tragic loss of life of two Jewish men who were preventing an attacker from entering their synagogue. The attacker also died. Three days later, in an unrelated attack, the mosque in Peacehaven was set alight by two arsonists. Fortunately, there were no injuries. Faith leaders, Jewish, Muslim and Christian have all condemned these attacks.

Catholics have also been the subject of persecution, ever since Roman times, but to our shame the Catholic Church has also been guilty itself of religious persecution of both Muslims and Jews.

But in 1965 our Church published 'Nostra Aetate', a groundbreaking document that fostered interfaith relations by acknowledging Christian roots in Judaism and encouraging respect, dialogue, and collaboration with Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, and other non-Christian religions. Here are two quotes which all Catholics should take to heart.

"The Church, mindful of the patrimony she shares with the Jews and moved not by political reasons but by the Gospel's spiritual love, decries hatred, persecutions, displays of anti-Semitism, directed against Jews at any time and by anyone."

"The Church regards with esteem also the Moslems. They adore the one God, living and subsisting in Himself; merciful and all-powerful, the Creator of heaven and earth".

On this Solemnity of St. Philip Howard who was martyred for his Catholic faith let us stand in solidarity with all those persecuted for their faith because [continued right]
