


Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.







Go through the maze to find each part of the Trinity.


Saint Patrick used a shamrock to teach about the Trinity. It has three leaves but is one plant, like the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three persons in one God.


Lazarus got very sick and died. Jesus went to his tomb and called out, "Lazarus, come out!" Listen to the Gospel to hear what happened next.


