


Ascension is listed without a date because most dioceses move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few dioceses in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on Thursday or Sunday.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

The Archangels Michael, Raphael, and Gabriel


Archangels are very special angels that each have different jobs.



Pray to Saint Martin instead of complaining when it is time to clean your room.









How many loaves of bread can you find in the picture?










Saint Cecilia

Saint Cecilia is the patron saint of musicians.


Saint Cecilia sang songs of love for Jesus. Listen to the music in church today. Do any of the songs sing about love?

Can you find all the instruments in this picture? There is an organ, a harp, and a guitar!






