


Moses was born in the land of Egypt. His parents were slaves, and their lives were very difficult.

The Hebrew people were treated terrible and the Egyptians made them build the huge pyramids.



Baby Moses: The Hebrews people were commanded to throw their baby boys into the Nile River because the Pharoah of Egypt became afraid the large number of slaves would one-day become stronger than the Egyptians and rebel. The parents of Moses hid their baby boy as long as they could and then placed him into a water-proof basket and put him into the tall grass that grew along the Nile.



The daughter of the Pharoah saw the little basket that the Bible calls an "ark." The princes loved the child and took him to live in the palace. The Lord protected Moses, and the princess of Egypt even hired Moses' mother to take care of the baby! The Lord really works wonders to take care of His people!

Moses as the shepherd: When Moses grew up, he realized that he was not an Egyptian but a Hebrew. He tried to protect one of the Hebrew slaves and eventually had to flee to a distant land called Midian where he became a shepherd out in the wilderness.



Moses saw burning bush: One day when Moses was in the wilderness with his sheep, he saw a strange sight. A bush was on fire, but it did not

burn up!



God spoke to Moses out of the burning bush and commanded him to return to Egypt and lead the Hebrews slaves to freedom and to a promised land of their own . . . a land God that said was "flowing with milk and honey."

Moses stands before Pharoah: Moses was afraid, but he did what the Lord commanded and with his brother Aaron as his spokesman, he stood before Pharoah and demanded that the people be set free to serve the Lord out of Egypt. Pharoah refused to let the people go so Moses performed a number of miracles to show that the Lord is King of kings and Lord of lords. The first miracle happened when Moses threw his walking staff down and it became a deadly serpent. The wise men of Egypt did the same thing, but the serpent of Moses destroyed all the snakes of the magicians!



Judgments of Egypt: The Pharoah didn't believe in the Lord and REFUSED to let the people go so God sent ten painful judgments against the land of Egypt. His first judgment was to turn all the water of the land into blood . . . and then flies and lice were everywhere.



Passover lamb: Finally, after more judgments upon the land, God told Moses that He would perform one more miracle and that Pharoah would then send the people away. The LORD instructed each Hebrew family to kill a lamb and put the blood on their doorposts. He also commanded them to stay inside their houses overnight. God said that the death angel would pass over all the houses that had the blood applied but the angel would take the lives of every firstborn child in all the land of the Egyptians.

The death of the lamb was a preview of Jesus' death on the cross. Jesus is even called "The Lamb of God" and He died to pay the penalty for all our sins. We must believe in Him and receive Him as our Savior in order to be saved.



Escape through the Red Sea: The people went out into the desert and came to the Red Sea. Exodus chapter 14 tells us that when Moses stretched out his staff by faith in the LORD, God caused a strong wind to blow all night, and the water of the Red Sea parted so that the people could escape on dry ground . . . right through the middle of the deep waters of the Red Sea.



When Pharoah's soldiers and his war chariots followed the Hebrews, the water suddenly came upon them, and they were all destroyed. God protected His people. What a great miracle and victory!



Some people say that Moses and the people walking through the Red Sea on dry ground is just a make-believe story and didn't really happen. But not too long ago, chariot wheels were found under the water of the Red Sea. What the Bible says is true and not just a made-up story!

Let's see how the chariot wheels were discovered!

An explorer by the name of Ron Wyatt was flying in a small airplane over the Red Sea when he looked down and said - "Wow! That looks like the place where the Bible says that Moses and the Hebrews were trapped between the mountains, the Red Sea, and Pharoah's army. I need to go down there and look around."



Nuweiba Beach is a modern-day resort area where tourists go on vacation. It is located at the end of a long winding canyon with steep mountains on both sides. Once Moses and the Hebrews people began walking down that canyon there was no escape! At least that's what Pharoah thought. Pharoah sent his army to fight with the Hebrews and force them back into slavery. The Hebrews were terrified when they saw all the chariots and Pharoah's army coming down the canyon.

[&]quot;And Moses said to the people, 'Do not be afraid. Stand still and see the salvation of the Lord." Exodus 14:13

When Mr. Wyatt arrived at Nuweiba Beach, he found a large stone column lying in the water. He could tell that there was some writing on it, but the water had worn it away so that no one could read it. He wondered if there could be another column like this one on the other side of the Red Sea.

He and his son rented a boat and went eight miles across the Red Sea to the shore of Saudi Arabia. Mr. Wyatt knew that it is really dangerous to travel there without special permission, so they didn't stay there very long.



Guess what they found!

They found another stone column just like the one they had seen in the water at Nuweiba Beach. This column had writing in Hebrew that said - "To the Great God of the Hebrews Who delivered His people through the Red Sea." It is believed that King Solomon made those columns and put them on both sides of the Red Sea to mark the exact crossing site.


Mr. Wyatt thought, if this is the place where Moses and the people crossed over on dry ground, maybe there are still some chariot wheels at

the bottom. And He was right!

When they went swimming with some scuba diving equipment, Mr. Wyatt and his son began to find chariot wheels! One of them was even covered with a thin layer of gold. It was probably the chariot wheel from one of the army commanders or maybe even Pharoah's chariot!



They found more chariot wheels that were covered with coral which had grown onto the wood and preserved the shape of the wheels all these years!




They even discovered that the LORD had created an underwater land bridge that sloped gently down into the water that was 900 feet deep. The "bridge" was wide enough for the million freedom seekers to cross safely over with all their flocks, wagons and equipment!




Wow! God really takes care of His people! That underwater bridge was probably formed during the big flood in Noah's day! Other explorers have found many more chariot wheels underwater. They have even found bones from the horses that pulled the chariots. Moses crossing the Red Sea on dry ground actually happened just like the Bible says!


