## MAINTAINING THE HT COMMERCIAL (LOOSE-LAID) MATS AFTER INSTALLATION

- 1. If tape comes loose in certain areas, we recommend re-taping with fresh tape
- Should you encounter any tears in the HT
   Commercial Mat, we recommend taping in those areas. Alternatively, you can cut a piece of the matting from any leftovers and patch over the tear with tape
- 3. If significant rainfall occurs and pooling of water is evident on the matting, we recommend using a broom or squeegee to remove the excess water
- 4. Should you need to re-lay a new section of the matting, please refer to the <u>Product & Application</u>

  <u>Sheet</u> for installation steps
- 5. One of the main benefits with loose laying the mats is that you can peel up the matting every so often to check the slab
- 6. We recommend using a good quality cloth tape (e.g. Nashua 357 Gaffer Tape) to secure the seams of the mats together. Nashua Tape is available for purchase through Honcho Supplies.
- 7. We also recommend sufficiently weighing down/securing the mats when used externally to minimise risk of displacement due to wind and extreme weather events
