From children to elderly, Partnership services impact the entire circle of life in the Greater Chattanooga area. These programs are not only designed to meet the immediate needs of our most vulnerable community members, but to also lay the groundwork for lifelong success, stability, and independence.

#### **VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES**

**24/7 Crisis Hotline** provides trained crisis advocates who offer immediate support, resources, and safety plans to individuals and families affected by sexual assault and domestic violence.

**Domestic Violence Shelter** provides safe emergency shelter with 52 beds, crisis counseling, and ongoing support to survivors of domestic violence.

**Rape Crisis Center** provides confidential services to victims of sexual assault age 13 and over, including forensic medical exams, crisis counseling, community referrals, assistance with orders of protection, and court advocacy.

#### **ELDER SUPPORT SERVICES**

**Home Care Program** assists individuals over 60 years of age and disabled adults ages 18-59 to remain self-sufficient by assisting with the daily tasks of living, such as light housekeeping, grocery shopping, and accompaniment to medical appointments.

**Long Term Care Ombudsman** provides advocacy for residents in nursing homes and assisted living facilities. Advocates work to prevent elder abuse and ensure the needs of residents in assisted living facilities are properly attended to. To learn more, call 423.593.0072.
