If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

This fee also includes a percentage of all overhead expenses related to the cost of doing business. If any third-party providers charge for their services, the charges will be reflected on your statement.
