- Monitor the sessional, half termly and annual reporting that Learning Mentors produce.
- Review student attendance termly.
- Annual or end of course requests for feedback from commissioning schools or the Local Authority.
- Annual or end of course requests for feedback from students and parent/carers.
- Annual business planning process to identify objectives for EduDiverse Action Plan.
- Complete Annual Local Safeguarding Audit to ensure external quality assurance of Safeguarding.
