Career, Technical, and Agriculture Education (CTAE) Program at Brantley County High

Brantley County High School offers 19 different pathway options under 12 different program areas. These courses are vital to our students' education at BCHS. Our goal from year to year is to offer career and technical pathways that will expose the students to a wide variety of career options. Our pathways are also aligned with Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSO) to provide our students with opportunities to connect with students in our region, state, and even nationally. These organizations allow students to compete and gain valuable leadership skills.

The Brantley County Board of Education does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, or disability in any educational programs or activities or in employment policies. All students may participate in any CTAE program, as long as requirements are met for those areas that have program guidelines. The following details the programs and pathways offered at BCHS. The cluster and the pathways offered in that cluster are provided below, along with the CTSO that aligns with the cluster. For those clusters that have multiple pathways, the first, and sometimes second classes are the same. In those cases, It is the 3rd class that makes it a different pathway. Essentially, a student can take 4 classes in an area and earn 2 different pathways, such as in Ag. Education and Healthcare. Below is a list of the pathways and associated CTSO:

- Patient Care / Certified Nursing Assistant- This is a Dual Enrollment program with Coastal Pines Technical College and students become certified Nursing Assistants upon completion and board exams
- Sports Medicine
- Allied Health & Medicine



- Engineering and Technology
- Game Design
- Audio-Video Technology and Film



The following pathways are not associated with a particular CTSO:

- Welding (year-long)- This is a Dual Enrollment program with Coastal Pines Technical College and students are certified in two types of welding upon completion of the course.
- Cosmetology / Shampoo Tech (year-long)-This is a Dual Enrollment program with Coastal Pines Technical College and students are certified Shampoo Technicians upon completion
- Air Force Junior ROTC
- General Automotive Technology
