

The Solemnity of the Epiphany will fall on Saturday, January 4th in 2026.
Epiphany Blessing of the Home-Jan 4th "The first Epiphany was the visit of the Magi to adore the Christ Child. Marking doorways with chalk is a witness of faith. Use the chalk to mark above the main door, and over all exterior doors. (20+C+M+B+26)

- Numerals to consecrate the New Year 2026
- Initials to remind us of the Magi names-Caspar, Melchoir and Balthasar, and to represent the Latin motto: Christus Mansionem benedicat (May Christ bless this house.)
- Four crosses to represent the four seasons.
