From the Pastor's Desk

Dear St. Wenceslaus and Sacred Heart Parishioners,

I'm so honored to be your pastor and very honored to follow all the good work that Fr. Chinnappan has done. I'm very sad to see him return home, but I think he'll do well at his next assignment.

Nevertheless, I'm looking forward to getting to know you all and I know that Fr. Ward is too! I want to take just a little space here to go over one or two important matters, although I suspect that most of this will be familiar to you.

Concerning the Anointing of the Sick, please don't hesitate to call if you or someone you love (or even someone you don't love) is sick, elderly, declining, or especially, in danger of death. Please call myself or Fr. Ward while the sick person is still able to go to confession and receive the Eucharist, if possible. Often families will wait until the very last moment to call the priest, but often this is well after they can receive the fullness of the Church's sacraments. And this puts the person in danger of not receiving any sacraments if the priest is delayed for some reason in coming. If you are elderly or sick yourself, please let your family know your wishes to receive the sacraments!

With that in mind, I want you to know that Fr. Ward and I are here for you. Even if we don't live in Eastman or Wauzeka, it isn't too far and we want to be a part of your life and community. Please invite us over for coffee, supper, or just a visit. And Introduce yourself after Mass! If you ever need anything I can be reached at St. John's rectory 608-326-6511 or on my cell phone at 608-571-7808. Just be advised I might screen my calls as I get a lot of spam!

Finally, the most important thing is getting to heaven! That is our goal and God has put us together at this time and place to help each other get there. We will cling to Christ and His Church and you'll hear a clear refrain from me as the most important things we can focus on right now: 1. Daily and Deep Prayer, 2. Weekly Sunday Mass (or more often), and 3. Monthly confession!
