Where I Came From and Where I am Going.

I was born in a Catholic family and grew up in a little town called Fort Branch, Indiana. I have six older sisters and am the only boy. I went to Catholic grade school but did not feel the call to the Priesthood until I was 15 when I was a freshman. It was not an explicit call at the time, so I put it off for a few years. I graduated high school in 1999 and went to college for music. I got a degree in music in 2005. After college I went to work in a Toyota plant as an inspector.

It was at this time that I felt an explicit call to the priesthood in 2007. I never felt so much peace in my life as I did then. After discerning my home Diocese of Evansville in Indiana, I went to discern consecrated life as well. I went to a few religious communities and monasteries but ended up being accepted in the Marian Fathers in 2014. After almost five years with the Marians, I didn't feel called to them anymore but just to the Priesthood and to be a priest in Wisconsin. The Marians had a parish in Wisconsin and that is how I became familiar with Wisconsin and a desire to be here. I contacted Fr. Alan Wierzbza and he said that I can come to Independence, Wisconsin in a couple months in 2019. I moved to Sts. Peter and Paul Parish in Independence March of 2019, and lived with Fr. Woody Pace for a few months. In the fall, I joined the Regency program and then in 2020 was accepted at St. Francis de Sales Seminary. After studying there for the last five years, I graduated May 9th, 2025. I was ordained to the Priesthood June 28th, 2025 and was assigned to St. Paul in Bloomer and St. John the Baptist in Cooks Valley. In my first assignment with the good people of St. Paul and St. Johns has been really good. I taught music at the school and learned a lot from the pastor Fr. Feltes. Now, I look forward to being with all you!
