**The Big Idea**

Love is not just something we feel—it's something we *demonstrate*. One of the clearest ways we love our church is through **generosity**.

**1. Generosity Changes Lives**

“It is more blessed to give than to receive.” – Acts 20:35

- Generosity impacts more than finances—it transforms lives
- When we give, God uses it to meet needs and create opportunity
- True wealth is not what we keep, but what we release

**Truth:** Lives are on the other side of your generosity.

**2. Test God With Your Trust**

“Bring the whole tithe... test Me in this.” – Malachi 3:10

- Giving is not about money—it's about trust
- We often trust God with eternity, but struggle to trust Him with provision
- You will never experience God as Provider until you step out in faith

**Question:** Do I really trust God with what I have?

**3. Give It All Away**

“There was not a needy person among them...” – Acts 4:34

- The early church met needs because they lived open-handed
- Their generosity became a testimony to Jesus
- They didn't give leftovers—they reordered their lives

**Challenge:** What would happen if our church lived this way?

**Personal Reflection**

- What is God asking me to release?
- Where do I need to trust Him more?
- How can my giving impact someone else's life?

**Next Step**

As an act of faith and worship, prayerfully consider your commitment.
