## I Love My Church – Week 2: Love in Community Key Scripture: Hebrews 10:19–25

### 1. Jesus Crashed the Fence

We all have a “fence” of sin that separates us from God. But through Jesus’ death and resurrection, that barrier has been completely removed.

- Because of Jesus, we can **draw near to God with confidence**
- A relationship with God is now open to everyone
- Real community begins with a restored relationship with Him

### 2. Allow Others Into Your Yard

Even though Jesus removed the barrier between us and God, we often rebuild fences between ourselves and others.

- We show people our “front yard” (what looks good)
- We hide our “backyard” (our struggles and real life)
- But real love and community can’t happen from behind a fence

### True community means:

- Being authentic
- Letting others know us
- Living life together beyond Sunday mornings

### 3. Enjoy the Company

Biblical community doesn’t happen by accident—it takes **intentional effort**.

#### What this looks like:


- Encouraging one another
- Serving and helping in practical ways
- Spending time together
- Building meaningful relationships

### Practical Steps

- **Start small** – take one step toward connection
- **Be intentional** – don’t wait for others to come to you
- **Get involved** – join a group, stay after service, reach out
- **Be real** – allow someone into your “yard”

### Final Challenge
