God Never Said That...

Week 1: "Too Much to Handle"

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 1:8–10; 2 Corinthians 12:9–10

Myth: *"God will never give you more than you can handle."*

Many of us have heard this phrase during difficult seasons, but the truth is—it isn't found in Scripture. In fact, God's Word tells a different story. The Apostle Paul openly admitted that he faced trials "far beyond our ability to endure" (2 Corinthians 1:8). God never promised life would always be manageable; He promised His presence, His grace, and His strength.

Three Truths to Remember

- **God never promised you could handle everything.**
Sometimes life overwhelms us so that we learn to rely on Him instead of ourselves.
- **God promises His strength in our weakness.**
His answer isn't always to remove the burden, but to remind us, *"My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness."* (2 Corinthians 12:9)
- **God uses overwhelm to deepen our dependence on Him.**
Our greatest moments of weakness can become the places where we experience God's greatest strength.

This Week's Challenge

When you feel overwhelmed, replace the thought *"I should be able to handle this"* with this simple prayer:

"God, I can't—but You can."

Let His grace carry what your strength cannot.

Key Takeaway:

Life will give you more than you can handle—but it will never give you more than God can handle.
