Christmas: The Whole Story – Week 2 **“The Courage of Yes”**

God's work in the Christmas story moves from 400 years of silence to a daring moment of obedience. Mary and Joseph's courage to say “yes” to God opened the way for the Light of the World. Their example reminds us that God often calls ordinary people to extraordinary trust.

1. Following God's Call Can Be Scary

Fear does not disqualify us; courage moves us forward even when fear remains.

2. It's Easy to Make Excuses

God doesn't require perfection. He asks for willingness, small steps of trust repeated again and again.

3. Our “Yes” Unlocks Amazing Things

Every yes invites God to write His story through us.

Reflection for the Week

- What is God inviting me to say yes to right now?
- Where am I hesitating, and why?
- How might my obedience become part of God's larger story?

Takeaway

Mary and Joseph show us that courage isn't the absence of fear — it's trusting that God is already in the places He's calling us to go
