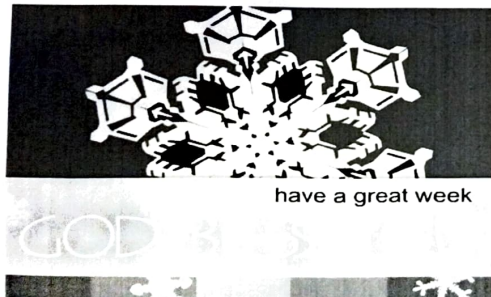

Called & Anointed – Week 1: God's Calling

1. Clearing the Way for God's Call

Common sources of interference include:

- Busyness and constant noise
- Unconfessed sin
- Spiritual immaturity
- Fear, doubt, and distraction from the enemy

Takeaway:

We must intentionally create space for God—through prayer, repentance, Scripture, and stillness—so we can hear His voice clearly.

2. Answering God's Call

Key truths:

- God's voice becomes clearer as we grow closer to Him
- The enemy seeks to confuse, distract, and discourage
- Obedience often requires faith, courage, and trust

Takeaway:

Like Samuel, we must learn to say, "*Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening.*" and respond in obedience—even when the call feels difficult or uncertain.

3. Discerning God's Call in Community

God uses community to provide:

- Wisdom and discernment
- Accountability and encouragement
- Confirmation and spiritual growth

Final Encouragement

God is still calling.

The question is not whether He is speaking—but whether we are listening.

Let us clear the interference, listen carefully, walk together in community, and boldly answer God's call.
