### **Called & Anointed - Week 2: God's Anointing**

#### **Big Truth**

God does not choose the way the world chooses. He looks beyond outward appearances, calls the unlikely, and works powerfully through our weakness.

#### **1. God Looks Beyond the Packaging**

When Samuel saw Jesse's sons, he assumed the strongest and tallest must be God's choice—but God reminded him:

*"People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."* (1 Samuel 16:7)

#### **Key Takeaway:**

God does not anoint appearances, résumés, or reputations. He anoints hearts that are humble, faithful, and available.

#### **2. God Calls the Most Unlikely People**

David—the youngest, overlooked shepherd—was chosen over his older brothers. This pattern repeats throughout Scripture:

- Moses, slow of speech
- Gideon, from the weakest clan
- Rahab, an unlikely outsider

*"God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise..."*  
(1 Corinthians 1:27)

#### **Key Takeaway:**

Feeling weak, overlooked, or unqualified does not disqualify you—it positions you for God's work.

#### **3. God's Power Is Revealed in Our Weakness**

God's anointing reveals His power, not ours.

*"My power is made perfect in weakness."* (2 Corinthians 12:9)

#### **Key Takeaway:**

Our weakness creates space for God's power to move through us.

#### **Final Encouragement**

God still anoints ordinary people for extraordinary purposes.

The question is not, *"Am I strong enough?"*

The question is, *"Am I willing?"*

Seek God's heart, trust His calling, and walk in the power of His Spirit.
