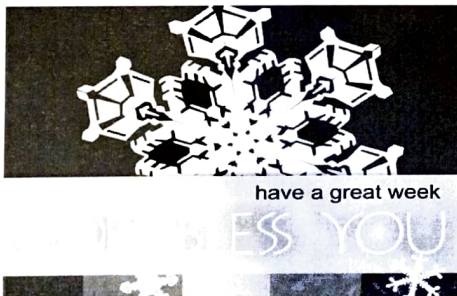

1. Recognize Where the Real Battle Lies

David did not see Goliath as just a physical enemy—he recognized a spiritual battle that challenged the name and power of God.

Key Truths:

- Our struggles are often spiritual, not just physical or emotional
- The enemy uses fear, lies, and discouragement to weaken our faith
- God equips us with spiritual armor and spiritual weapons

2. Realize God's Desire to Use Us

David stepped forward not because he was qualified, but because he was willing and trusted God's faithfulness.

Key Truths:

- God looks at the heart, not experience or position
- God often calls the unlikely and overlooked
- Faith requires obedience and stepping out courageously

3. Remember the Battle Belongs to the Lord

David's confidence rested in this truth: victory comes from God, not human strength.

Key Truths:

- God fights for His people
- Praise and worship invite God's power into the battle
- Victory comes through surrender, not control
