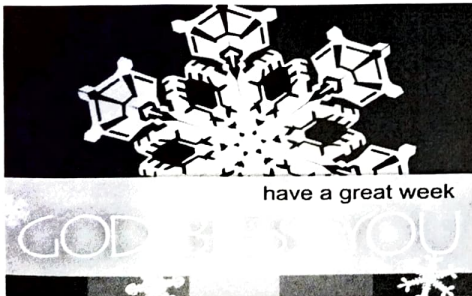

## Lent: Repent & Reflect

Lent is a sacred season of returning to God.

### **1. Repentance — Turning Back to God**

Repentance means more than feeling sorry. It means changing direction.

- God desires transformed hearts, not outward displays.
- Repentance is the doorway to renewal.
- Lent invites us to honestly examine our lives.

Ask yourself:

What habits, attitudes, or distractions need to be surrendered to God?

### **2. Reflection — Examining Our Hearts**

Just as Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness, Lent calls us to slow down and listen.

- Create space for prayer and Scripture.
- Invite God to search your heart.
- Move from surface faith to deeper trust.

Ask yourself:

Where is God calling me to grow?

### **3. Forgiveness — Receiving & Extending Grace**

Forgiveness is at the heart of the Gospel.

- We receive mercy through Christ.
- We are called to extend mercy to others.
- Forgiveness releases bitterness and restores freedom.

Ask yourself:

Is there someone I need to forgive—or grace I need to receive?
