Week 1: Gather for Encouragement

Hebrews 10:24-25

“Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds...”

Why We Gather

God created us for community, not isolation. From the beginning, faith was meant to be lived together. One of the primary reasons we gather as the church is to **encourage one another**, especially in seasons when faith feels difficult or weary.

1. Spur One Another On

Encouragement is intentional, not accidental. Hebrews calls us to actively *spur* one another toward love and good deeds. Like logs in a fire, we burn brighter together. When we isolate, our faith cools—but when we gather, God uses community to keep our hearts alive and focused on Christ.

2. Don't Give Up

Faith is a journey, and there are moments when giving up feels easier than pressing on. Gathering reminds us that we are not alone. Sometimes simply showing up is an act of faith. The church becomes the voice that says, *“Keep going. God is not finished with you.”*

3. Do It More, Not Less

As we grow in Christ, gathering should feel more natural—not less necessary. Fellowship is not an obligation; it is an expression of who we are becoming. We gather not because we are weak, but because we are being shaped together into the body of Christ.

A Call to Respond

Commit to fellowship. Encourage one another. Stay connected. As we see the day of Christ approaching, may we choose **more encouragement, more love, and more community—not less.**
