A Faith That Forms Generations
Key Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:5

The Big Idea

Faith that impacts generations is not built in big moments—it is formed through **quiet, consistent faithfulness at home**.

- 👉 **1. Faith Is Caught Before It Is Taught**
 - Timothy’s faith was described as **“sincere”**—real and without pretense
 - Children learn faith by **watching it lived out daily**
 - Everyday moments matter: prayer, repentance, worship, consistency
- 👉 What you live speaks louder than what you say
- 🏠 **2. The Home Is the Primary Discipleship Place**
 - God uses **homes, not just churches**, to form faith
 - Biblical examples: Hannah, Mary, Lois, and Eunice
 - The church supports—but **does not replace—the home**
- 👉 Faith is formed in conversations, routines, and relationships
- 🌱 **3. Generational Faith Is Built Over Time**
 - Faith grows through **small, repeated “yeses”**
 - Prayer, Scripture, forgiveness, and trust—again and again
 - The goal is not perfection, but **pointing to Jesus**
- 👉 You plant. You water. God brings the growth
 - ✨ **Encouragement**
 - You are not responsible for outcomes—only **faithfulness**
 - No prayer is wasted
 - No act of obedience is unseen
- 🎯 **Final Challenge**
 - Model humility and repentance
 - Build simple, consistent rhythms of faith
 - Play the long game—God is working beyond what you see
