Big Idea

Confession is difficult, but it is the doorway to freedom.

1. We Squander It All

The story of the prodigal son reminds us that many of us begin our journey by believing we know better than God.

At first it may feel like freedom, but eventually the cost of sin becomes clear. Scripture reminds us:

2. No Longer Worthy

The turning point of the prodigal son’s story comes when he “comes to his senses.” He recognizes his sin and prepares to return home in humility.

True confession means:

- Acknowledging our sin honestly
- Taking responsibility
- Turning back to God

3. Alive Again

The most beautiful moment in the story happens when the father runs to meet his son.

Instead of punishment, the son receives:

- Compassion
- Forgiveness
- Restoration

“This son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.” – Luke 15:24

Application

The prodigal son’s story is really our story.

Wherever you are today, the invitation is the same:

Come home to the Father.
