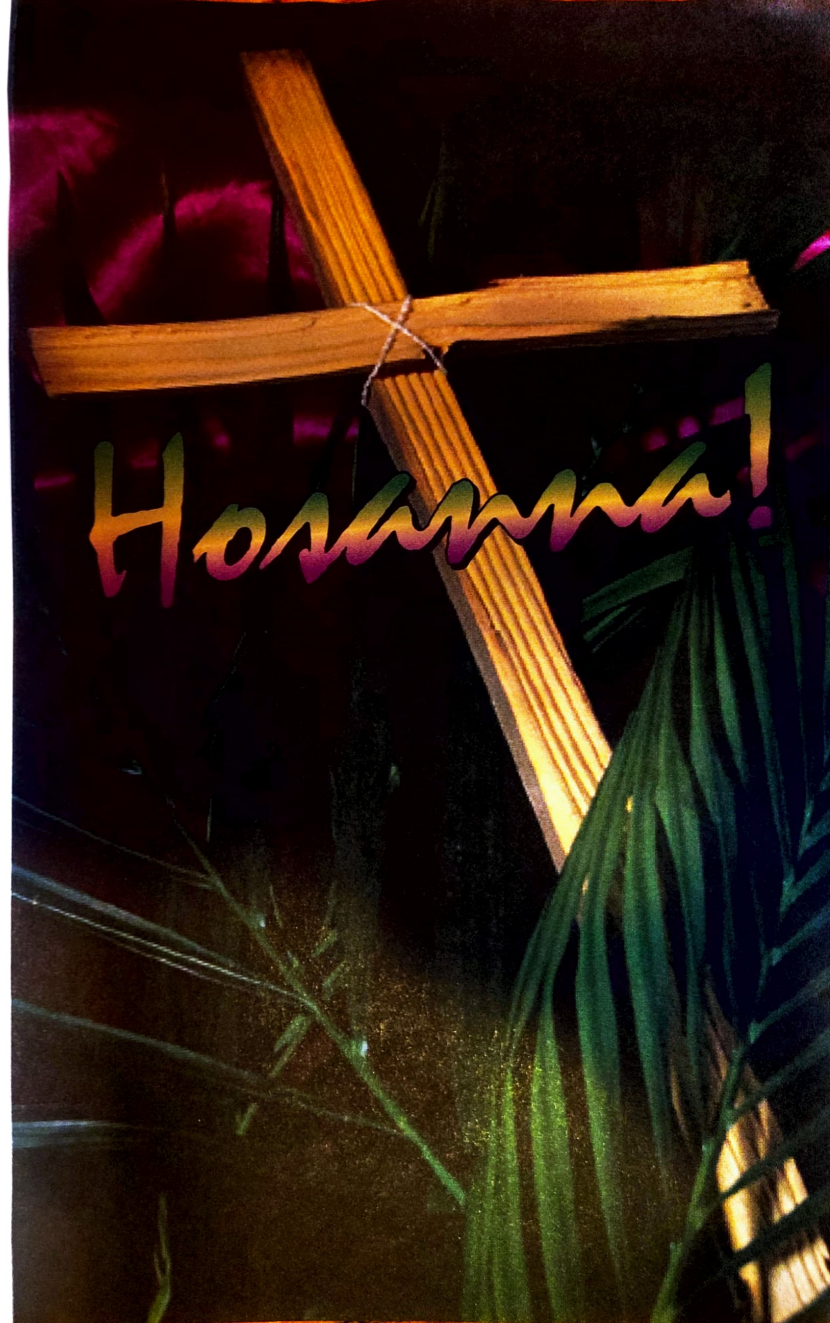

Big Idea

The sacrifice of Jesus is complete and eternal. Through His life, death, and resurrection, we are redeemed—and called to live lives of sacrifice for Him and for others.

1. Humility & Sacrifice

Jesus, though fully God, chose to humble Himself.

- He left heaven for earth
- He took on the form of a servant
- He became obedient—even to death on a cross

True sacrifice always involves humility.

2. There Is a Cost

Following Jesus requires sacrifice.

Discipleship means:

- Letting go of control
- Surrendering priorities
- Choosing Christ above all else

A life of faith is intentional—worth the cost, but never without it.

3. Crucified with Christ

When we follow Christ:

- Our old life no longer defines us
- Our identity is found in Him
- We live by faith, not by self

We don’t just follow Jesus—we are transformed by Him.

4. It’s Worth It

Jesus saw beyond the suffering to the joy of redemption.

When we live sacrificially:

- Our lives gain purpose
- Our actions impact others
- We experience lasting joy

- What is God calling you to surrender?
- Where is He inviting you to live more sacrificially?
- How can your life point others to Christ?
