WHAT TO WEAR?

Company Dancers:

- -NO t-shirts or cover-ups in class
- -NO Apple Watches or any "wrist bands" that you can contact someone with
 - -NO wrist bracelets
 - -NO ankle bracelets
 - -NO rings
- -NO dangling earrings
- Only Small earrings and small necklaces are fine
- -If wearing warm ups they must be taken off the 10 mark of class
- -If wearing athletic shorts you must have tights underneath



Girls Attire:

Ballet - Solid colored leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Hair secured back and off the neck in a bun. Technique only students are required to wear black leotard, neutral bra (if needed) and a secured bun.

Jazz – Sports bra, half top, crop top, tank top or leotard with dance shorts or leggings. No athletic/gym shorts or sweatpants.

Athletic/gym shorts can be worn as long as long as tights are on underneath. Black or tan jazz shoes.

Dance sneakers will only be allowed for hip hop classes and working out.

Tap - Same attire as jazz with tap shoes at the discretion of the teacher.



Ballet – A fitted t-shirt, solid colored shorts or joggers/sweatpants, and black ballet shoes.

Jazz - Same attire as ballet with black jazz shoes.

Dance sneakers will only be allowed for hip hop
classes and working out.

Tap - Same attire as jazz with black tap shoes
