PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends.

One thousand three hundred and thirty-eight beatifications; four hundred and eighty-two canonizations - these are the stats from the papacy of Pope Saint John Paul II. JPII completely broke all previous records for Popes when it came to recognizing and formally declaring real-life holiness through the beatification and canonization process!

John Paul II canonized young people, lay people, working people, professors, missionaries, ordinary parish priests, religious sisters, athletes, musicians, artists, poor, rich, educated, illiterate, martyrs, farmers, and so many more. He didn't do this merely to show the Church's tremendous diversity across every nation and culture. Rather he did this to show that a life of holiness is within reach of all who believe in Jesus Christ.

Today's second reading declares: "All Scripture is inspired by God...so that one who belongs to God may be competent and equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

Saint Paul excludes no one in this declaration. As disciples of Jesus Christ who listen to the Word of God every Sunday we are all equipped for "every good work." We are all called - and equipped by faith, the sacraments, and God's Word - to live a holy life. It may lead to an eventual posthumous canonization - or it may not - but the truth remains the same that the best version of you is the <u>holy</u> version of you!

Be inspired by the life and teachings of Pope St. John Paul II, whose feast day is this week (October 22nd). Let his record-breaking number of beatifications and canonizations encourage you to live life to the full by living a holy life as a disciple of Jesus Christ in the Church that He founded.

"True holiness does not mean a flight from the world; rather, it lies in the effort to incarnate the Gospel in everyday life, in the family, at school and at work, and in social and political involvement."





Proposed Constitutional Amendments: Be Vigilant!



Proposed Amendments to Virginia's Constitution would:



Create a radical "fundamental right" to abortion

(Opposed by VCC)



Restore voting rights (Supported by VCC)



Remove Virginia's "union between one man and one woman" definition of marriage (Opposed by VCC)

These three proposals were **initially approved** by the General Assembly earlier this year. If they pass the legislature again in 2026 – and are then approved by Virginia voters on a ballot – they would become law.

The legislators we elect this November will decide whether the proposed amendments are advanced or stopped.

Extreme, Radical and Deadly Abortion Amendment

This proposed amendment would enshrine virtually unlimited abortion at any stage of pregnancy as a "fundamental right" in Virginia's constitution.

In addition to the paramount problem of not recognizing the child's life, the amendment:

- Does not include any age restriction
- Does not include any safety standards
- Jeopardizes Virginia's parental consent law
- Jeopardizes Virginia's conscience protections for healthcare providers
- Expands Virginia's already permissive abortion laws
- And has numerous other problems!

Abortion is a fundamental tragedy, not a "fundamental right".

Ending a life is not a right and does not belong in the constitution.

Proposed Constitutional Amendments:





Amendment Rejecting the Truth about Marriage

This proposed amendment would remove Virginia's constitutional definition of marriage as the "union between one man and one woman." It would add language recognizing "any lawful marriage between two adult persons" instead.

Marriage was created by God as the union of a man and a woman. God's design and purpose for marriage existed before any nation, religion or law.

The family – based on marriage between a man and a woman – is the fundamental unit of society and is integral to the common good.

Marriage – as created by God – is essential to the common good. Each of us is called to preserve God's design.



Amendment Restoring Voting Rights

This proposed amendment would restore voting rights to all people who have completed their prison sentences.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, "It is necessary that all participate...in promoting the common good. This obligation is inherent in the dignity of the human person.... As far as possible, citizens should take an active part in *public life*" (nos. 1913-1915).

Enabling individuals, upon release, to resume taking an active part in voting decisions affirms their dignity and provides them a second chance to fulfill their duty to participate in promoting the common good. It enables them to have a say in decisions that affect them, their families and their communities.

As the U.S. Catholic Bishops have noted, restoring voting rights is an important aspect of reintegration:

"[W]e must welcome ex-offenders back into society as full participating members, to the extent feasible, and support their right to vote."
