PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

Today is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time (before Advent) in which we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. This feast was instituted 100 years ago (1925) by Pope Pius XI, as an effort to celebrate the reign of Jesus not only in the spiritual sense but in the full sense of his complete kingship over our lives and the whole of creation. As St. Paul writes, "God has put all things under his feet." (Ephesians 1:22)

My favorite prayers in today's Mass are found in the Preface: "As king He claims dominion over all creation, that He may present to You, His almighty Father, an eternal and universal kingdom: a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love, and peace."

Jesus wants to present all of us to His Father; we ourselves are Christ's most prized possession. He wants to possess our hearts and so be able to present us to the Father as that very same kingdom of truth, life, holiness, grace, justice, love, and peace.

Pray about which area of your life you are withholding from Jesus. By faith you do know Him as your Savior-King. But in what area of your life are you not fully submitting to his kingship, to his merciful reign? As you approach the altar today to receive the King of Kings in Holy Communion, ask for the grace to submit that particular area of your life to Him.








St. Vincent de Paul

Rooted in the compassion of St. Vincent de Paul and the bold service of those who followed him, our parish St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) conference remains committed to bringing Christ's love to families in crisis — thanks to your generosity.

Recently, we assisted a mother of two young children, ages 6 and 1, after her car was vandalized by local minors, leaving her with \$1,800 in repair expenses. Having only recently begun working at Inova Hospital and sharing housing costs with her mother, she suddenly found herself unable to cover November's rent. Your support ensured stability for her family while she awaits a mid-December court date to seek restitution.

We also helped a mother of two who fell behind on a past-due utility bill, receiving a cutoff notice despite doing her best to keep up with current expenses. After months of homelessness earlier this year, she recently started a part-time job to rebuild her finances. With your help — including a payment toward her energy balance and food cards to reduce monthly costs — she can focus on staying safely housed and moving forward.


Follow along with the guided meditation as we pray Lectio Divina with a passage from the Gospel of Luke.
