PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

"He's complicated." "She's complicated."

Generally these statements are not compliments. On the contrary simplicity is a virtue. A spiritual writer explains this virtue:

"Simplicity excludes every form of duplicity and complication stemming from egoism, self-love, or attachment to self and to creatures; hence it impels the soul in one direction only: to God, to live for Him, to please Him, and to give glory to Him. The whole spiritual life consists in this progressive simplification which proceeds at an equal pace with interior purification. When a soul is perfectly purified from every passion and attachment, then is it reduced to perfect simplicity, that simplicity which makes it live only in God and for God." (Dan Burke, President of the Avila Foundation).

The month of November has been dedicated to praying for the dead, and to thankfulness. These two devotions prepare us perfectly for the holy season of Advent which begins today. Advent is a time to simplify our hearts by focusing on the humility and simplicity of our Savior. He comes as a child, quietly and simply.

You'll notice that the music and liturgy of Advent is a bit quieter. For example, we do not sing the Gloria in the Mass, and there is more a cappella singing. The Sacred Liturgy quiets our hearts in order to simplify them.

Be sure that the commercial aspect of the season does not disrupt the interior preparation that we are all making during these next four weeks. Let us all make ourselves simple-hearted, in preparation for the child-like joy of a holy Christmas.

I encourage you during Advent to give more attention to the Word of God. The Bible is the book that reads you! Before Mass take a few minutes to read the Gospel passage; even better, read the passage as found in the New Testament available here in the pews. Give space to the Word of God in your life, and be assured that the Christmas celebration of the Word Made Flesh on December 25th will be all that it should be!





generosity is greatly appreciated!






Lectio Divina: A Guided Meditation
