

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Baptism of the Lord. As we know, the Lord Jesus had absolutely NO need to be baptized; rather it was He Who sanctified the waters and also gave an example for us to follow.

By Baptism we are incorporated into the whole life of Christ: his life, death, and resurrection. By baptism we are made brothers and sisters in Christ, children of the same Heavenly Father. We are also made members of God's Holy Church, "living stones" in the great temple of God which is the Catholic Church (cf. 1 Peter 2:5).

Today's feast calls to our attention this critically important truth: the Catholic Church is NOT to be equated merely with her hierarchical members (Pope, bishops, priests, etc.). Rather the Catholic Church is the whole Mystical Body of Christ of which every baptized Christian is a member - that means YOU!


"Holy lay people are the Church's showpiece." Read those words again and believe them.

Lay people who are living a life of faith *in the world* are the greatest sign of the Church's holiness. You are the presence of the Church *in the world*. You come to the parish seeking the sacramental graces and the spiritual formation that you need. But then your calling as lay faithful is not to spend all day at Church, but rather to be *in the world* sanctifying it as holy men and holy women, bringing the light of God's grace to every corner of the world by the way you live your life as a disciple.

Your life as a disciple began with your baptism, so happy feast day to you! Today the Church celebrates the Sacrament which enkindled in your soul the fire of love for God which makes you a light in this broken world!




