Are You Grieving?

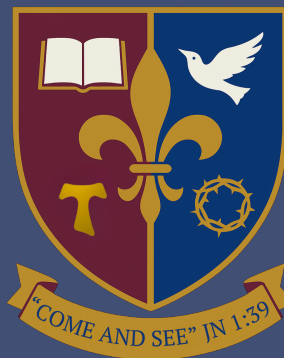
