



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends.

Today's second reading gives us these beautiful words: "Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself...[and today] every tongue confesses that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Philippians 2:6-11)

Scripture scholars tell us that this passage in Philippians is a hymn. What we're reading are the lyrics of a song, an early Christian hymn. Don't we all wish there was a recording of the original? Don't we all wish we could learn how to sing the original version of this hymn?

But actually there's something very appropriate about <u>not</u> having that recording, of <u>not</u> knowing how it sounded. Because **the life of Jesus is itself the song**, the hymn of praise sung for love of God the Father. The life of Jesus is music to His Father's ears. And each of us, as disciples of Jesus, is likewise called to make of our own life a hymn of praise. Each 'yes' that we say to every cross that we carry joins us to the great 'Yes' of Jesus on the Cross of Redemption.

Be assured that Jesus is immensely pleased with you and "hears" the song that you sing with your life of trials and sufferings. To assist you with your prayer and meditation today, I offer you the lyrical poem below as we celebrate the Triumph of the Cross.

"I See His Blood upon the Rose" By Joseph Mary Plunkett

Your Pastor,

Father O'Hare

I see his blood upon the rose
And in the stars the glory of his eyes,
His body gleams amid eternal snows,
His tears fall from the skies.
I see his face in every flower;
The thunder and the singing of the birds
Are but his voice—and carven by his power
Rocks are his written words. All pathways by his feet are worn,
His strong heart stirs the ever-beating sea,
His crown of thorns is twined with every thorn,
His cross is every tree.





St. Vincent de Paul

Your generosity enables the Saint Louis St. Vincent de Paul (SL SVdP) Society to provide critical assistance to neighbors facing financial crises.

Recently, we helped a grandmother raising her 16-year-old granddaughter avoid a water shutoff after her income from housecleaning declined during the summer months. She is hopeful to resume regular payments this fall.

We also assisted a dedicated nurse and mother of a 5-month-old who fell behind on rent after her baby's NICU stay and job transition. Immediate help prevented eviction while she begins training for her new nursing role.

Another neighbor, a mother of two, needed utility assistance after giving birth in June. She had to leave work early and does not receive summer pay from her school job. To help keep the lights on for her newborn,

we paid part of her utility bill and provided \$200 in Aldi food cards (donated by Holy Spirit's SVdP) to reduce her monthly expenses until her paycheck resumes in late August.
