PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends.

The word that appears prominently in today's Gospel is "disciple" from the Latin word for one who learns, "discipulus." In the time of Jesus the Hebrew word was "talmid," which means more than just a learner. It means a person who submits his/her life to the one who is the Teacher. We are all disciples of Jesus, and we not only learn from him but we also follow him with all of our heart, mind, soul, and strength.

I am <u>very</u> happy to invite you to a new opportunity to deepen your life as a disciple by learning your Catholic Faith at a graduate course level. This new weekly class will be taught by Fr. Thompson and myself every Sunday from 10am-10:45am. Fr. Thompson and I both have a passion for teaching and we are really looking forward to being your theology professors!

The class is entitled: "Come and See: A Graduate Level Course in Theology."

This course will take THREE YEARS to complete. Yes, THREE YEARS.

What I promise you is this: if you attend this course faithfully for three years the result will be that you will acquire a graduate level knowledge of your Catholic Faith. There will be no major topic of our Faith which you would not have learned to some meaningful degree. (We will post a video recording of each class on our website, in case you miss a class or two from time to time.)

Now is the time for you to really become a disciple of Jesus! To become more than a learner, to have more than just a rudimentary knowledge of the most important things. What do we believe and why we do we believe it? And what impact do these beliefs have on my real life? This course will answer all of those questions.

The textbook for the class is over 400 pages and is used in graduate level courses in theology across the country.

"Come and See" starts next Sunday. * Coffee and tea will be available for the 15 min prior to formal beginning of the class at 10am. *




