



Proverbs 2:1-8; Deuteronomy 29:29


Westminster From the Pew to the Pulpit then Back to You Devotions (July 7 - 12)


<b>Monday</b> : Read Proverbs 2:1-8. Review your notes from yesterday's sermon. What was mos helpful to you about yesterday's sermon?
