

11 And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, 13 waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. 14 For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

15 And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying,

16 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, declares the Lord:

Summary: Because Christ's "single sacrifice for sins" achieved the forgiveness that animal deaths could never provide (Heb. 10:12), his "single offering" results in the "perfecting" and "sanctifying" of those who draw near to God through him (10:14). Throughout Hebrews, "perfect" ... [expresses] the consecration qualifying priests (and other worshipers) to approach God's presence in worship. - Dennis E. Johnson
