

from thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead





SCRIPTURE READING

Hebrews 10:1-10

1 For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities, it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect those who draw near. 2 Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have any consciousness of sins? 3 But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. 4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

5 Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said,

"Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me; 6 in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.

7 Then I said, Behold, I have come to do your will, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book.'"

8 When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), 9 then he added, "Behold, I have come to do your will." He does away with the first in order to establish the second. 10 And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

This is the Word of the Lord.

Themes: The Law, Sacrifice, Atonement, Typology

Summary: The difference then which the Apostle makes between the Law and the Gospel is this,—that under the Law was shadowed forth only in rude and imperfect lines what is under the Gospel set forth in living colours and graphically distinct...Law was not useless, nor its ceremonies unprofitable...We must however observe, that the things which were shewn to them at a distance are the same with those which are now set before our eyes. – John Calvin
