

CHARITY & CHEER WINDOW WALK

This year, the Festival of Trees is launching an exciting new community-centered program designed to benefit local nonprofits and enliven downtown Sandpoint. Twelve nonprofits will have the opportunity to partner with local downtown businesses to host a decorated tree and raise funds directly through a custom raffle. Each nonprofit keeps 100% of the raffle proceeds, with only a \$100 participation fee to help cover event marketing and logistics.

The event runs November 28 - December 6, culminating in a community-wide raffle drawing during the Starlit Soiree Gala.

HOW IT WILL WORK:

- 1. Nonprofits and downtown businesses apply to participate
- 2. Nonprofits and downtown businesses get paired up
- 3. Nonprofits and business partner decorate the tree to their chosen theme
- 4. Nonprofit receives gift certificate to purchase artificial tree
- 5. Nonprofits and business partner sell raffle tickets for their tree, at any price you choose and keep 100% of the proceeds.* The Envision Center will be selling passport booklets at all Festival of Trees events.
- 6. The tree will be up November 28-December 6th and the winner will be drawn December 6th and announced at the Starlight Soirée Gala
- 7. December 7th the business needs to be open for nonprofit volunteers to pack gifts and wrap trees so they are available for pick up by our drivers.

Gingerbread Competition

THE SWEETEST TRADITION CONTINUES

In 2024, the Community Resource EnVision Center proudly hosted the second annual 4th Grade Gingerbread Competition as part of the beloved Festival of Trees. Thanks to the generous support of Durfee Construction, this growing tradition welcomed seven schools and eleven fourth-grade classrooms from across Bonner and Boundary Counties to showcase their creativity and holiday spirit.

During Friends & Family Day, each classroom's gingerbread masterpiece was on full display for students, families, and community members to admire and vote on. The competition culminated at the Gala, where the winning creation, Valley View Elementary School's cozy "Campfire Trailer" gingerbread house, was auctioned off for \$4,000, benefiting their selected nonprofit, Boundary County Coalition for Families. In an incredible show of generosity, the gingerbread was donated back and re-auctioned three additional times, ultimately raising \$11,000. Of that total, \$7,000 was donated to support our mission to empower our community through connection, service and support.

We continue this tradition not only to celebrate youthful creativity, but also to plant seeds of philanthropy, collaboration, and community pride in our future generations. We understand the incredible demands placed on teachers and intentionally keep the competition simple and student-centered. This event offers an opportunity for camaraderie, creativity, and a touch of healthy competition among classrooms and schools.

- 2. No additional funding from teachers, parents, or students is allowed to be used towards the gingerbread creations
- 3. Gingerbread creations may be anything your classroom dreams up; castle, barn, village, camper, etc.
- 4. Gingerbread creations must fit on a 12"x16" baking pan or piece of cardboard. Be sure to put your classrooms name and contact info on the bottom of the baking pan or cardboard if you would like it back.
- 5. Take pictures of your classroom dreaming, designing and building your creation. Email them to Katie@crecidaho.com
- 6. The EnVision Center will showcase each classrooms gingerbread creations on our Facebook page
- 7. Each classroom is responsible for bringing their creation along with their entry form to The Hive at 207 N 1st Ave Sandpoint, ID 83864 on Friday, November 28 between 9am-3pm. Gingerbread creations will not be returned to the classrooms, we plan to deliver them to the nursing homes to be enjoyed there.

HOW TO WIN

- 1. Be creative, be a team, follow the rules above, and have FUN!
- 2. During the Festival of Trees Friends & Family Day on November 30th from 11am-2pm, guests will be asked to vote on their favorite gingerbread creation Encourage your class to come and see all of the other classrooms gingerbread creations and to cast their own votes!
- 3. The winning classroom will be announced at the Gala on December 6th and their creation will be put into the live auction.
- 4. The winning classroom will be rewarded with bragging rights, a pizza party, \$200 for their classroom, and a check in the amount that their creation goes for in live auction. An EnVision Center representative will bring the pizza to the winning classroom and present them with their checks while sharing with the classroom the value of their participation and the importance of the work nonprofits do in our community.
