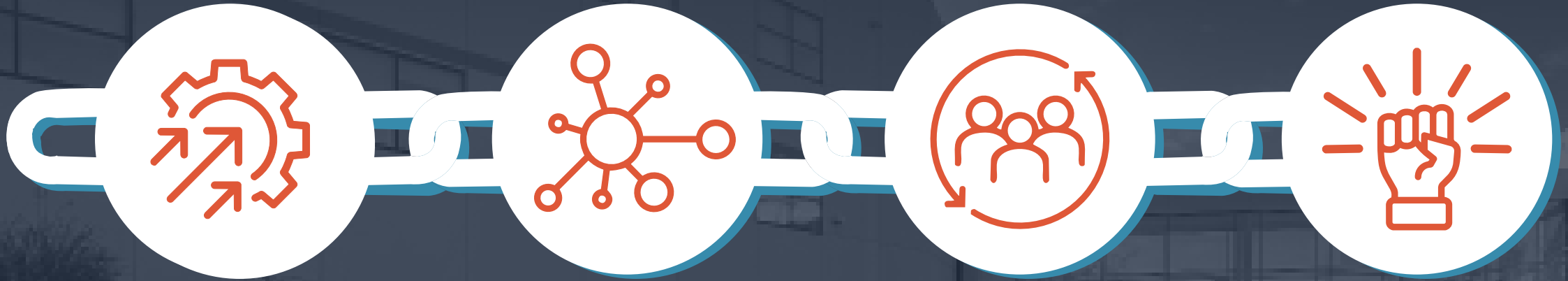
A place where you find:

This Model Is Already Working

- ✓ 14,300 square feet of active shared space
- ✓ 17 Nonprofit and 18 for-profit partners co-located
- ✓ Shared resources and infrastructure
- ✓ Reduced operational costs
- ✓ Strengthened collaboration and relationships
