## TOUR ITINERARY:

### DAY 1: PHOENIX - HANOI

Please arrive in time at Phoenix International Airport for your flight to Hanoi. Enjoy inflight meals and services. Overnight on board

### DAY 2: INFLIGHT

Continue your flight to Saigon. Relax, recline, and enjoy inflight meals and services onboard. The date changes when International Dateline is crossed in Pacific. Overnight Onboard the Flight

### DAY 3: HANOI ARRIVAL (-/-)

Welcome to Vietnam! Upon arrival at Hanoi International Airport, proceed through immigration and customs. Once you exit the arrivals hall, our representative will be waiting with a "Pick-up" sign and will escort you to your vehicle for a transfer to your hotel in the city center, approximately 30–40 km away with an estimated travel time of 30–40 minutes. After check-in, relax or explore the vibrant Old Quarter at your own pace for the rest of the day. Overnight in Hanoi



### DAY 4: HANOI - HALF-DAY MORNING PVT TOUR (B/-)

After breakfast, embark on a profound journey through Vietnam's history and culture with a private morning tour. Begin at the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, honoring Vietnam's revered leader. Nearby, visit the iconic One Pillar Pagoda, symbolizing purity as it rises from a lotus pond. Continue to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university dedicated to Confucius, and wander its serene gardens to explore the nation's scholarly legacy. Conclude with a breezy cyclo ride through Hanoi's Old Quarter, where historic streets blend traditional and modern life. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore Hanoi's markets, savor street food, or relax by Hoan Kiem Lake. Overnight in Hanoi

**Please note:** The tour operates from 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM. The Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is closed every afternoon, on Mondays and Fridays, and from mid-June to mid-August for annual renovation. During closures, the Ho Chi Minh Residence and other parts of the complex remain open. Guests are advised to wear clothing that covers knees and shoulders.

### Optional: Hanoi Foodie Private Tour - Street Food and Backstreet Experience: \$120 p/p on Private basis

Embark on a 4-hour culinary adventure in a vintage open-air Jeep, exploring Hanoi's vibrant food scene. Visit Michelin Guide–recommended restaurants and hidden local gems, tasting iconic dishes like Pho, Banh Mi, Bun Cha, Pho Cuon, Pho Ga, and the legendary Egg Coffee. Cruise through bustling

streets and narrow alleys, savor local treats like sticky rice with yogurt or Vietnamese ice creams, and end at a lively pub with a refreshing glass of Bia Hoi. This tour blends authentic flavors with cultural immersion.

**Please note:** Tour is available daily at 5:00 PM or your preferred time.



### DAY 5: HANOI - FULL DAY HALONG BAY CRUISE (B/L/-)

After breakfast, depart for Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and board your cruise with a welcome drink. Sail through stunning limestone karsts and emerald waters, passing creatively named islets like Cock Fighting and Thumb Island. Enjoy a sumptuous 40-dish buffet lunch onboard. In the afternoon, explore the Bo Hon archipelago, visit the Surprising Cave with its fascinating stalagmites and stalactites, and enjoy kayaking or a bamboo boat ride in Luon Cave's tranquil lagoon. Visit Titov Island for panoramic views before sailing back to Tuan Chau Harbour. Return to Hanoi in the evening.

**Please note:** Tour pick-up is between 7:45 AM and 8:45 AM, returning around 8:00 PM. The itinerary may change or be canceled due to weather, tide levels, or operating conditions. Shared transfer. Additional charges may apply for kayaking or pick-up from hotels far from the city center.

### DAY 6: HANOI - HO CHI MINH CITY (BY FLIGHT) (B/-)

After breakfast, your guide will transfer you from your hotel to Hanoi Airport (25–30 km, ~30–40 minutes) for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival at Saigon International Airport, proceed to the arrivals hall, where our representative will meet you with a "Pick-up" sign and transfer you to your hotel (~8 km, ~40 minutes). The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore the city's vibrant streets or relax.

**Please note:** Collect your baggage and proceed through the baggage check before meeting our representative in the arrivals hall.



## DAY 7: HO CHI MINH CITY - CITY TOUR AND CU CHI TUNNEL

(B/L/-)

After breakfast, begin with a guided walking tour of Ho Chi Minh City's iconic landmarks. Stroll along vibrant Nguyen Hue and Dong Khoi streets, admiring the colonial architecture of the Saigon Opera House and Central Post Office. Pass the historic Reunification Palace and reflect on Vietnam's past at the War Remnants Museum. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, journey to the Cu Chi Tunnels, an underground network showcasing the Viet Cong's resilience. Explore narrow passageways, learn about guerrilla warfare, and watch a documentary for historical context. Return to your hotel in the evening.

**Please note:** The city tour operates from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM, and the Cu Chi Tunnels tour from 1:30 PM to 6:30 PM.

## DAY 8: HO CHI MINH CITY - SIEM REAP (BY FLIGHT) (B/-/-)

After breakfast, meet your guide at the hotel lobby for a transfer to Saigon International Airport for your flight to Siem Reap. Upon arrival at Siem Reap Angkor International Airport, your guide will greet you and transfer you to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure, relaxing or exploring Siem Reap's vibrant markets and cafés.

### Optional: Phare Cambodian Circus \$45 p/p - advance booking required

Experience Cambodia's artistic heritage with a 1-hour performance of acrobatics, aerial ballet, mime, and storytelling at the Phare Cambodian Circus. This contemporary show, run by an NGO supporting disadvantaged youth, blends modern artistry with traditional Khmer stories and music.

**Please note:** The show runs from 7:30 PM to 9:00 PM.



## DAY 9: SIEM REAP - FULL DAY ANGKOR TEMPLE TOUR (B/L/-)

After breakfast, explore the iconic temples of Angkor. Begin at Angkor Wat, the largest and best-preserved Khmer temple, renowned for its intricate carvings and grand architecture. Cross its vast moat and admire the 1,700 Apsara sculptures and the Churning of the Ocean of Milk bas-relief. Continue to Ta Prohm, where towering trees intertwine with ancient ruins. After a lunch break, visit Angkor Thom, entering through the monumental South Gate. Explore the Terrace of the Elephants, Terrace of the Leper King, and the mysterious Bayon Temple with its enigmatic stone faces. Return to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

### Optional: Magnificent Sunrise at Angkor Wat - \$55 per person

Rise early for a sunrise visit to Angkor Wat. Your guide will take you to prime photo spots and lead a peaceful walk around the temple (exterior only) in the soft morning light, offering a serene experience.

**Please note:** The tour runs from 5:00 AM to 7:30 AM.

## DAY 10: SIEM REAP - FULL DAY BANTEAY SREI TEMPLE AND TONLÉ SAP LAKE (B/L/-)

After breakfast, visit Banteay Srei, the "Citadel of Women," celebrated for its exquisite red sandstone carvings. Continue to Preah Dak village to observe traditional craft weaving, sample local treats like Num Tnot (palm sugar cake), and see rice noodle production. After lunch in Siem Reap, board a boat to explore Tonlé Sap Lake's floating villages, where homes, schools, and markets float on Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake. Learn about the lake's ecosystem and resilient communities. Return to your hotel for the evening.

### Optional: Apsara Dance & Traditional Cambodian Dinner - \$50 p/p

Enjoy a mesmerizing Apsara dance performance with vibrant costumes and graceful choreography, paired with a flavorful buffet of authentic Cambodian cuisine.
