Winning entries will be published in The International Osprey Foundation's "*Osprey Lovers Calendar*" and will be posted on the TIOF website, social media platforms and in local print media. There will be 12 winning photos, one for each month, plus the overall winning Calendar Cover photograph.

Competition Rules:

- Contest begins on Sept. 15, 2022. It ends no later than October 15, 2022
- Only amateur photographers may enter contest
- You must submit an executed Entry Form with each photograph
- Contestants may submit up to 3 digital images
- Each image must be submitted INDIVIDUALLY in its own individual email, with the name of the photograph as the subject
- Images must be in jpg form – to be no less than 5MB but not to exceed 19MB.
- Images may not contain watermark or signature
- Images should be submitted as attachments to an email addressed to:
photocontestTIOF@gmail.com beginning on Sept. 15, 2022, and no later than October 15, 2022
- Images shall be renamed according to details on the contest entry form. Forms and contest rules are posted on the TIOF website www.ospreys.com, as well as on the Maryland Osprey and Nature Festival site www.marylandospreyfestival.org, and the Virginia Osprey Festival site, www.virginiaospreyfestival.org
- The photographer must attest that the images produced were in fact taken by the photographer and that they are the copyright holder

- Winning entries will be published in The International Osprey Foundation's "*Osprey Lovers Calendar*" and will be posted on the TIOF website, social media platforms and in local print media. There will be 12 winning photos, one for each month, plus the overall winning Calendar Cover photograph. Additional Honorable Mention awards may be made at the judges' discretion.
- The copyright for all submitted images shall remain the property of the photographer but winning entrants grant The International Osprey Foundation the right to use submitted images without additional cost in publicity materials associated with the 2022 Calendar and future TIOF promotional materials
