

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR WILBARGER MEMORIAL PARK INC.
VERNON, TEXAS

October 15, 2023

1. Cemetery spaces, mausoleum crypts, and columbarium niches are for sale and are quoted by Sullivan Funeral Home located at 1801 Houston Street in Vernon, Texas.
2. A fee as prescribed by law of 1.75 per square foot of space or 15% of sale price, whichever is greater, is charged and placed in a perpetual care fund with the Trust Department of the Waggoner National Bank. Perpetual Care fee for mausoleum crypts are as follows: Single \$105 or 7%, whichever is greater. Double \$165 or 7%, whichever is greater. Perpetual care fee for columbarium niche is \$35 or 15% of sale price, whichever is greater. Crypts and niches are sealed with a sealant and reopening is not permitted.
3. All grave openings and closings and set ups will be done by Wilbarger Memorial Park staff. Charges for these services can be obtained at Sullivan Funeral Home.
4. Interment receptacles; A minimum requirement of a steel box is required, and sold by our firm. We also offer steel vaults of all descriptions. For further information contact Sullivan Funeral Home. No concrete boxes, concrete vaults, or pine boxes will be permitted. A minimum requirement of an urn vault is required for burial of cremains. An outer container is not required for entombment or niches.
5. Second right of interment for cremains are allowed at Wilbarger Memorial Park, but are limited to one casket and on set of cremains, or two sets of cremains.
6. All markers and monuments are to be granite, marble, or bronze and must be a flat marker set flush with the ground. As of June 15, 2022, upright monuments are allowed in the Rose Garden in designated rows. Markers and monuments must be four inches thick and a minimum of twenty-four inches by twelve inches. Temporary markers are permitted, but must be flush with the ground and are not allowed after six months from date of burial.
7. A continuous marker fee of \$0.30 per square inch is charged for each marker or monument placed at Wilbarger Memorial Park. Setting fee for vases is \$50.00.
8. Wilbarger Memorial Park must order your marker or monument not later than 21 days after you have paid 100% of the cost of the marker or monument; you have paid in full all charges for the interment space and corresponding required perpetual care, you have paid in full any maker or monument setting fees; you have approved the lettering and design for the marker or monument; and you have signed the necessary documentation directing or authorizing Wilbarger Memorial Park to order the marker or monument.
9. Wilbarger Memorial Park must set your marker not later than 15 days after you have inspected and accepted the marker, and you have paid in full all charges for the marker and interment spaces, including required perpetual care fees.
10. Wilbarger Memorial Park must set your monument not later than 25 days after your have inspected and accepted the monument, and you have paid in full all charges for the monument and interment spaces, including required perpetual care fees.
11. If Wilbarger Memorial Park is unable to set your burial marker or monument by the aforementioned deadlines, Wilbarger Memorial Park will notify you in writing not later than the 5th day after the date by which your marker or monument is required to be set and inform you of the reason for the delay, and the date by which Wilbarger Memorial Park expects to be able to set your marker or monument.
12. Maps for Wilbarger Memorial Park are furnished for the locations of graves free of charge at Sullivan Funeral Home.
13. Hours of operation are sun up to sun down. No one is allowed on cemetery grounds after those hours. No loitering, littering or consumption of alcoholic beverages are allowed.
14. No concrete curbing is allowed in any part of the cemetery. No planting of trees or shrubs are allowed other than designated places mapped out.
15. All watering is under the regulation and management of Wilbarger Memorial Park staff. No personal type work will be allowed without consent of the management.
16. No pets are allowed in Wilbarger Memorial Park. Interment of animals are prohibited.
17. Flowers are permitted in vases only. Gorham bronze vases are required for markers. Granite and marble vases are allowed for monuments. Flowers may be place on crypts and niches provided they are placed in flower urns.
18. All funeral flowers will be removed three days following burial.
19. Concrete bench placement is at the discretion of Wilbarger Memorial Park management.
