STAFF REPORT & REQUESTED ACTION

The Homeland Security Advisory Committee (HSAC) met on April 8, 2026, to prioritize FY27 projects for the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) and Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities (LETPA). Due to an atypical funding increase last year, the HSAC created two priority lists for submission to the Office of the Governor (OOG).

To ensure no funding is left on the table, the HSAC developed two distinct priority lists: one based on historical "normative" levels and a second based on the increased allocation amount we received last year. Once approved, both options will be submitted via eGrants for OOG review. The projects recommended for Executive Committee ratification are listed below.
