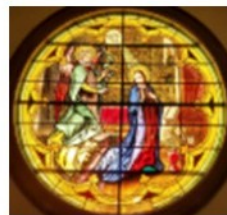

FESTIVAL PLANNING MEETING, January 25th after Mass

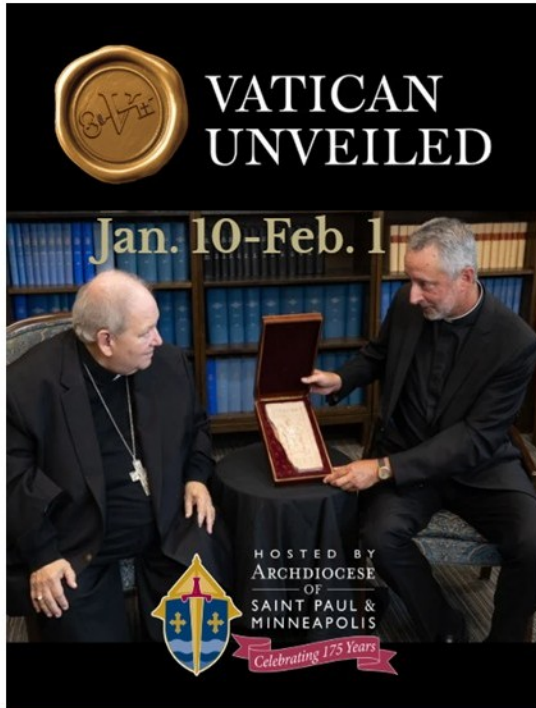
