## 175th Anniversary Mass

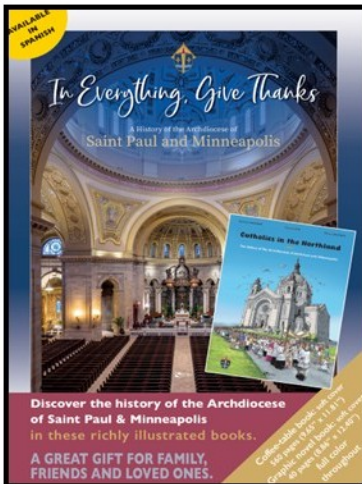
