Because of this seasonal reality, I will not see many of you as my assignment here concludes on June 30.

I am looking forward to the potluck meal after Sunday Mass this weekend. I have enjoyed these events with their fellowship and high-quality cuisine. I thank the generous and hard-working volunteers who are making this happen, only one week after our labor-intensive parish festival!
