  come to a close, has graciously agreed to continue serving for another term. In addition, Mike
  Wallin has been nominated for the role of Vice Chairperson, and Christina Nelsen has been
  nominated to serve as Secretary.
- We also currently have one open position on the Parish Council. This is a wonderful opportunity
  for a parishioner who feels called to serve and contribute to the leadership and spiritual

- <u>Father Justus</u> Father will now be working out of the Parish Office at Annunciation on Tuesdays and Thursdays. With this change, we are exploring updates to our weekly schedule to better serve our parish community. Possible changes include adding Adoration and a Thursday Mass, as well as moving Tuesday Mass to the morning. These ideas are open for discussion, and no decisions have been made. Father welcomes your input on Mass times, Adoration, or other ways to enhance parish life. Please share your thoughts with Father directly or through the parish office as we work together to create a schedule that supports spiritual growth and participation.
- Other Reports The Altar & Rosary Society is still seeking a volunteer to serve as President of
  the group. In the meantime, members have come together to share responsibilities and divide
  duties in a way that reduces the overall time commitment for any one person. This collaborative
  approach makes it easier for everyone to participate meaningfully without placing the full
