Games:

Regulation game times less 5 minutes. All games will be played at the Stenger Soccer Complex, or Long Lake Regional Park, in Arvada, Colorado. Each 9U – 15U team will be scheduled to play a minimum of three games. Generally, Semi-final matches (if needed) will be played on Sunday afternoon with finals & consolation matches scheduled for Monday.

We do our best to accommodate coaches who are coaching multiple teams within our tournament. In order to ensure minimal conflicts, all teams the coach is coaching **MUST** be registered under the coaches account with the same coach email!!

Teams will be placed in Divisions based on number of teams registered, level of play and ability level. Our best efforts will be used to divide registered teams equally into divisions, based on divisional standings, division currently playing within CSA, and recommendations from the coaches, however placement is ultimately dependent on the current list of registered teams within the age group. Divisions may be:

- **Gold Division**
- **Silver Division**
- **Bronze Division**
- **Red/Blue/White Division- if needed**

8U teams will be scheduled to play 4 games on Saturday & Sunday only. The first 3 games will be randomly scheduled in a "festival format". The tournament will conclude for these age groups with the "celebration round", where teams with similar records will be matched for the final game.

Awards:

Participation medals will be awarded for 8U players. 1st through 2nd place medals will be awarded in each division for 9U-15U.

Officiating:

A certified referee will officiate all games. 9U through 15U teams may be required to provide a qualified parent/volunteer linesperson for each of their scheduled games. If you have anyone interested in officiating games at our tournament, please contact refeducation@coloradoreferees.com.

Confirmations:

Confirmations will be e-mailed to all teams who are accepted. Registration fee must be paid in full in order for a team to be accepted into the tournament. Additional tournament information, Guest Player Form, online check-in directions will be included with acceptance email and on the web-site. All teams **must** check in online by the designated check-in date.

General Information:

Each participating team may be required to provide a qualified Linesman for their games..

- All participants and coaches will receive a commemorative Tournament pin.
- Additional tournament pins, patches, t-shirts, sweatshirts and merchandise will be available for purchase at the tournament headquarters.
- Concessions will be available at the tournament

TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN LIST - Teams will not be allowed to check in the day of the tournament!

- ✓ Roster
 - Competitive Team roster must be state certified
 - Developmental teams- 9U and older and Intermediate Team rosters must be state certified
 - Developmental rosters 7U and 8U must be club issued and signed by registrar
- ✓ Player passes, or picture roster-11U-15U teams only- 7U-10U teams do not need them. Bring to games- not needed for check in.
- ✓ Completed Guest Player Form (if needed)
- ✓ Medical Release Forms (for all players including guest players)
- ✓ Rec and Intermediate teams do not need numbers on their jerseys.
- All teams **MUST** use the Stenger Invitational online check-in. Detailed instructions will be emailed to team contact.
