## PREFACE.

We present to our patrons, and to the public, our first Directory of Cedar Falls, trusting they will appreciate it's value.

As in every enterprise of this character, we had a great many obstacles to contend with, all of which, we feel, we have overcome.

We put forth every effort in our power to obtain the names of all persons who should appear in a City Directory, and we flatter ourselves that we have produced a Directory as nearly complete as a work of the kind can well be, although errors will appear in compiling so many names.

The history of a majority of the cities in the State of Iowa. all built within the last thirty years, is little more than a biography of their early settlers, and a sketch of the enterprise in which they have been engaged.

Cedar Falls is beautifully located at the falls of the sparkling river from which it derives its name, ninety-nine miles from Dubuque and two hundred and twenty-seven miles from Sioux City. It is a lively place--much more so than places containing more inhabitants, because a junction is formed here with the Burlington, Cedar Rapids & Minnesota Railroad, thus making it a railroad center. The surrounding country is fertile, rolling and well watered, has fine farms and

thrifty orchards.

In 1845 the first permanent settlement was made in Black Hawk county, by E. D. Adams and William Sturgis, on the land now occupied by this flourishing city. The first cabin was erected on the spot where now stands the city prison, on First street. In 1821 a few lots were located and a town platted. In 1853 it was re-platted and recorded. It then contained nine cabins and forty-one souls. The following year a store-house was built and opened up by J. R. Cameron. Owing to the superior advantages of the place, immigration began to come in, and before the close of the year it contained nearly 300 inhabitants.

Here, for the first time on the main line of the road, do we cross the Cedar river. Its crystal waters tumble over a rocky bottom from a point at the west side of the city, until lost again in the steady current below. This is the second river of importance in the State. It rises in the lakes in southern Minnesota, a few miles north of the Iowa line. Its meandering course is traced through quite a number of the leading counties until it comes within 10 miles of the Mississippi river. After crossing the C., R. I. & P. R. R., where it bends gradually to the southwest, it flows on some 25 miles, and then forms a junction with the Iowa river, in Louisa county, at the crossing of the south branch of the C., R. I. & P. R. R., leading to Washington. After its junction it takes its name from the Iowa river. The length of the main stream is about 350 miles, and it drains about 8,000 square miles. Steam boats in an early day run up as far as Cedar Rapids.
