2016 Celebrity Grand Marshals Milk and Honey



Milk and Honey was originally formed in 1967 and was based in western Iowa. The name of the band comes from a poem called "The Land of Milk and Honey."

The group used an old school bus to travel during the first year of performing. In 1971 the band found a female lead singer, Maureen Hastings. This was an improvement for Milk and Honey since there were few bands with female lead singers at the time. After releasing the hit song "Have a Nice Day" in 1974, the group decided to perform only in the Midwest. Milk and Honey was later inducted into the Iowa Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2004. The group has appeared at the Sturgis Falls Celebration for the past several years.

The band members have changed over time, but currently the group includes Rick Koch on bass guitar, keyboards, and vocals; Maureen Hastings on keyboards and vocals; Roger Miller on lead guitar, bass guitar, and vocals; John Arntson on drums; Wayne Risvold on guitar, bass guitar, keyboards, and vocals; Lis March on rhythm guitar, saxophone, keyboards, flute, and vocals; Brent Hastings on harmonica, sound tech, and vocals; and Eric Ver Steegt on tech support.

These days the members of Milk and Honey like to focus on making music and having fun.

2016 Cornerstone Award El Kahir Shrine







The Board of Directors is pleased to honor El Kahir Shrine and Ron DeVoll who serves as the Potentate of the El Kahir Shrine. El Kahir Shrine is part of Shriner International and Shriners Hospitals for Children. These hospitals provide free care for children with spinal cord injuries, cleft palates, burns, and orthopedic conditions.

The Shriners began in 1872 in New York City. The organization originally came from a group of Masons who wanted to step away from the serious part of the group to focus on fun and fellowship instead. The Shriners have grown to 350,000 members in 191 Temples across the world.

The Shriners raised money in their early years to fund their organization, but eventually the funds exceeded their needs. They decided to use the money toward helping children with polio. When polio was cured, the Shriners built a hospital to provide care for children with orthopedic conditions. This grew into the 22 Shriners Hospitals for Children in North America today.

The largest fundraiser in Iowa for the Shriners Hospitals for Children is the Iowa Shrine Bowl. Donations each year from this event range from \$65,000 to \$80,000.
